

1- way serpentine (1 cold wall)


2- way serpentine (2 cold walls)

3- way serpentine (3 cold walls)

Installer may choose to not drill & pull pipe through joist and do turns under joists

## Acceptable Floor Coverings for Radiant Heating

Most floor coverings can be installed over radiant heating. Solid hardwood can be installed over radiant heating, though certain conditions must be met.\*




Parallel Headers Setup

Quartersawn vs. plainsawn recommended. Heating element can not be directly under hardwood. Dense hardwood over 1375 Janka is advised against by some installers.
